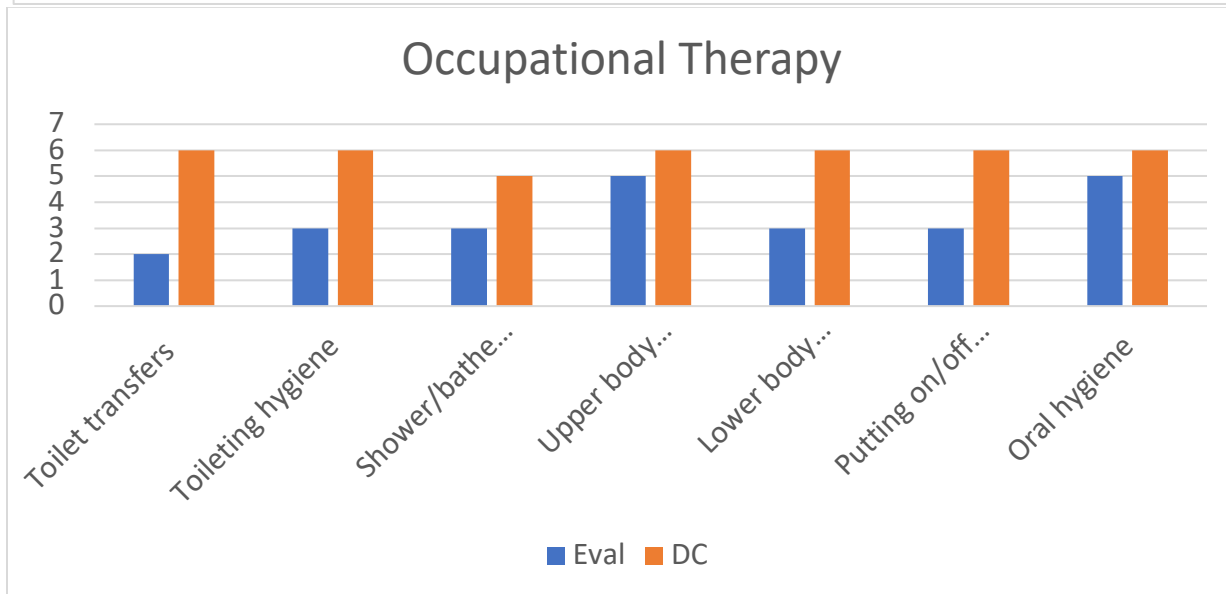
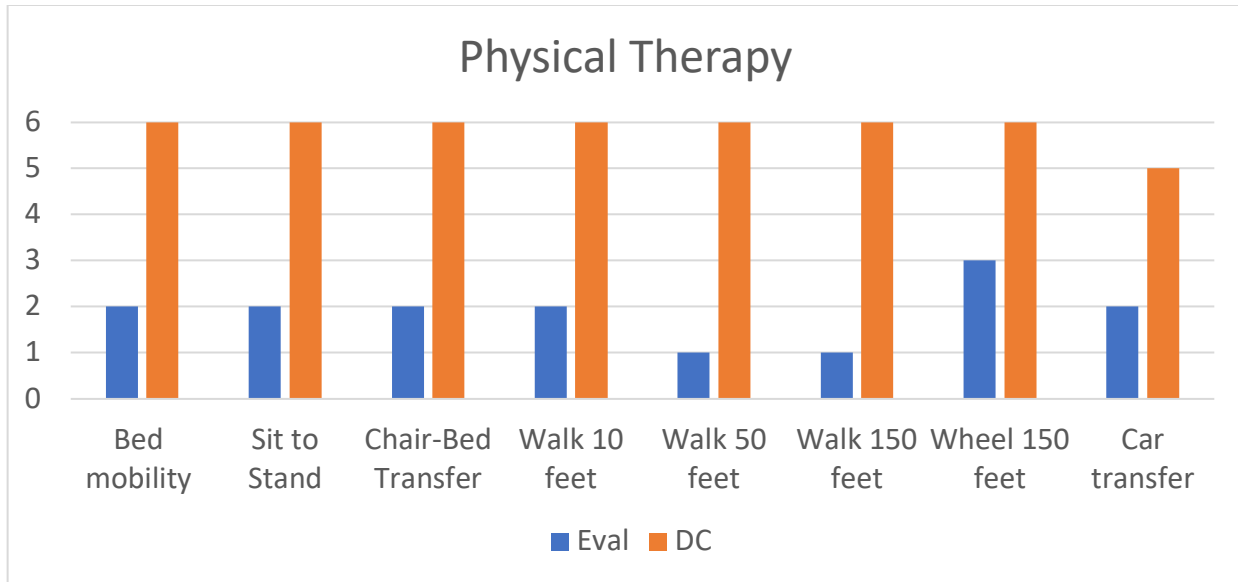
Dx: Fall with left LE pain, Hyponatremia

Admit: 05.31.24

Discharge: 06.25.24

Destination: Home alone w intermittent assist from caregiver & friend.

Mrs. Braxton is an 69-year-old female who came to Hewitt to regain independence with her self-care tasks, the ability to stand, walk, and to increase her overall strength after having a hospital stay for a fall at home with left LE pain, no evidence of fracture and hyponatremia. She admitted requiring minimal assist for activities of daily living (ADL's), Moderate assist with bed mobility, moderate assist for transfers and maximum assist with ambulation up to 10ft with a RW. She was having moderate pain to Left hip during weight bearing & all functional tasks, fatigued easily with low activity tolerance requiring rest breaks after minimal activity. Due to her hard work, decreased pain and persistence in achieving independence to return home, patient met all her goals of SBA/Mod I with a RW & WC for ADL's, Independent with bed mobility, mod I transfers, wc mobility and ambulation with a RW up to 350ft with SPV/mod I. She was able to discharge to home alone with intermittent assist from caregiver, friend & continue therapy with HH.



MDS Section GG Functional Scores	
06 - Independent	Completes the activity by him/herself with no assistance from a helper
05- Setup or clean-up assistance	Helper sets up or cleans up; patient completes activity. Helper assists only prior to or following the activity.
04 - Supervision or touching assistance	Helper provides verbal cues and/or touching/steadying and/or contact guard assistance as patient completes activity. Assistance may be provided throughout the activity or intermittently.
03 - Partial/moderate assistance	Helper does LESS THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts, holds, or supports trunk or limbs, but provides less than half the effort.
02 - Substantial/maximal assistance	Helper does MORE THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts or holds trunk or limbs and provides more than half the effort.
01 - Dependent	Helper does ALL of the effort. Patient does none of the effort to complete the activity. Or the assistance of 2 or more helpers is required for the patient to complete the activity.
