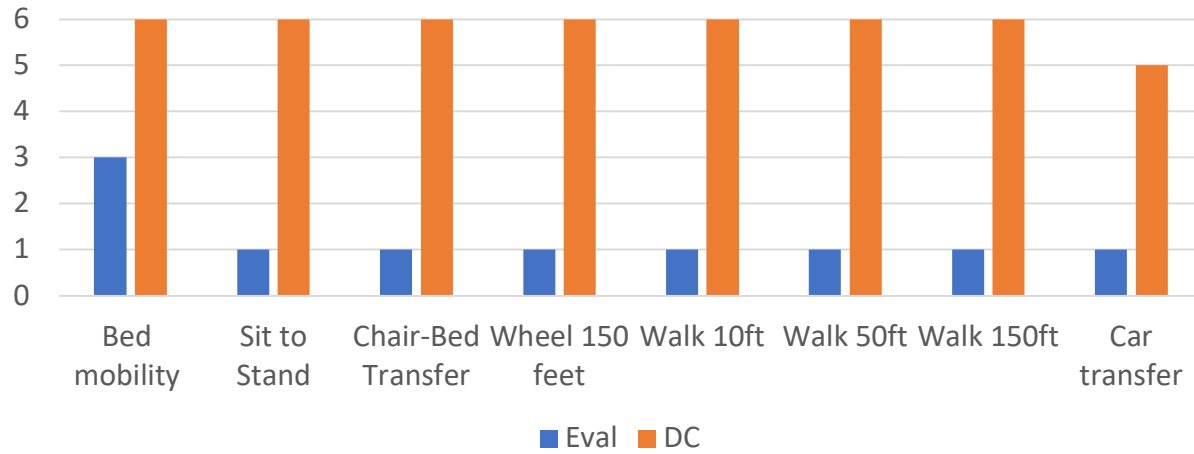

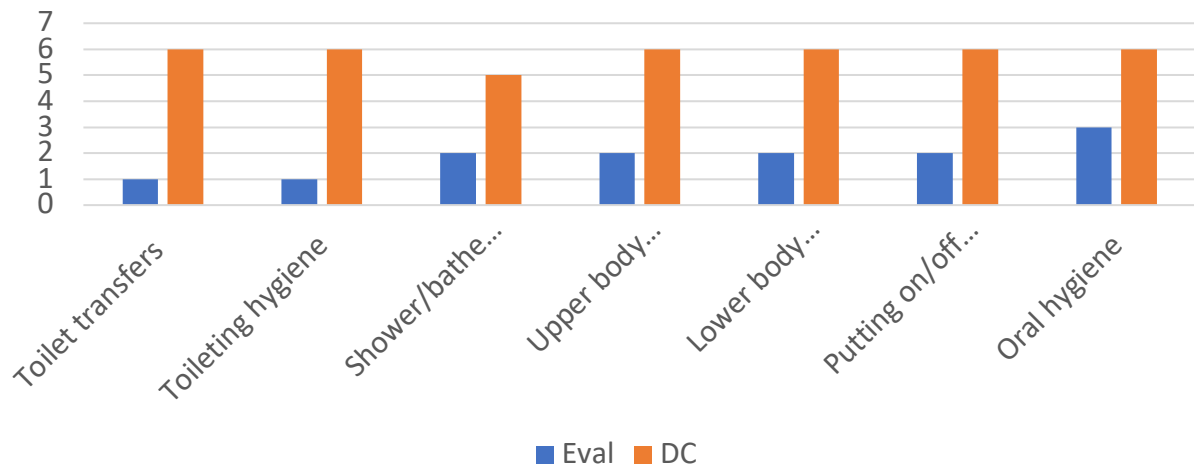
Destination: Home with son.

Mr. Jentoft is a 77-year-old male who came to Hewitt to regain independence with his self-care tasks, the ability to stand, transfer, walk at home and to increase his overall strength after having two hospital stay's for NSTEMI and respiratory failure. He participated in PT/OT requiring maximum assist with activities of daily living's (ADL's), minimum assist with bed mobility, unable to perform stand pivot transfers or OOB mobility due to severe dizziness & low blood pressure. He had some confusion with difficulty finding motivation for getting out of bed or functional mobility. Due to his ability to get motivated, perform the hard work with strong family support, clearing of his confusion & dizziness with persistence in achieving independence to be able to return home, the patient met all his goals of Modified Independent (Mod I) for all ADL's, I with bed mobility, Mod I for transfers, wc mobility, SPV for ambulation with a RW up to 300ft. He was able to discharge home with his son to continue therapy with home health.

MDS Section GG Functional Scores

06 - Independent Completes the activity by him/herself with no assistance from a helper
05 - Setup or clean-up assistance Helper sets up or cleans up; patient completes activity. Helper assists only prior to or following the activity.
04 - Supervision or touching assistance Helper provides verbal cues and/or touching/steadying and/or contact guard assistance as patient completes activity. Assistance may be provided throughout the activity or intermittently.
03 - Partial/moderate assistance Helper does LESS THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts, holds, or supports trunk or limbs, but provides less than half the effort.
02 - Substantial/maximal assistance Helper does MORE THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts or holds trunk or limbs and provides more than half the effort.
01 - Dependent Helper does ALL of the effort. Patient does none of the effort to complete the activity. Or the assistance of 2 or more helpers is required for the patient to complete the activity.
